Thank you for your interest in applying for a scholarship to attend the **45th Annual FACAP Training Seminar** to be held March 1-3, 2023 at the Florida State Fire College in Ocala, Florida.

The scholarship is available only to those individuals employed in public fire service, law enforcement or criminal prosecution. FACAP has established approximately 50 full scholarships that include housing in the dormitory at the Fire College, and the registration fee and all materials.

If you are interested in attending the seminar and wish to apply for a scholarship, please print out and complete the attached scholarship application and submit it to the Fire Services and Law Enforcement Sub-Committee members as indicated below.

Please select Scholarship #1 or #2, depending if you require a room in the dorm. (*Do not select* #1 unless you intend to stay in the dorm.)

Selection is based on a number of factors, such as present duties, number of other personnel attending from your department, attendance by scholarship at previous seminars, etc. On receipt of the application, the committee will immediately review and determine your eligibility. You will be promptly notified by electronic mail as to whether you have been approved for the scholarship. If at such time a waiting list develops, selection will be based on eligibility and date of application.

Once you have been approved, you will be provided with directions on how to register for the seminar on-line at <u>WWW.FACAP.ORG.</u> Those registering under the Scholarship will be given direction for purpose of waiving any registration fees.

Please do not apply for a scholarship unless you are certain of being able to attend and you have the approval of your supervisors. We have a limited number of scholarships available. If you are selected and do not attend, you could be preventing someone else from attending under a scholarship.
